

We encourage everyone reading this statement to think about the land that The Assembly Theatre is on, who the traditional keepers of the land are, and what the treaty relationship is. The Assembly Theatre is located on the Treaty Lands and Territory of the Mississaugas of the Credit and the traditional territory of the Anishinaabe, the Wendat, and the Haudenosaunee.

The territory is within the lands protected by the Dish With One Spoon Wampum Belt Covenant, an agreement between the Haudenosaunee and Anishinaabe and allied nations to peaceably share and care for the resources around the Great Lakes.

Today, the meeting place of Toronto is home to many Indigenous people from across Turtle Island, and we at The Assembly Theatre are grateful to live, work, and create on this land.
