

THE ASSEMBLY

Although we are thrilled to welcome audiences back to The Assembly Theatre, the health and safety of our patrons, artists, and volunteers remains top of mind.

While the theatre will begin resuming full-capacity seating for our production of *Two Minutes To Midnight* by Michael Ross Albert, in consideration of patron's comfort, Wednesday evening performances will be limited to 50% capacity.

We require all audience members, artists, staff and volunteers who enter the venue to be fully vaccinated, which means you have received two doses at least two weeks prior to visiting. Proof of vaccination paper or electronic documentation must be shown upon arrival. We will also be taking the temperature of everyone who enter the venue as well as enacting contact tracing protocols.

All audience members, staff, and volunteers are required to wear masks inside of the venue except when consuming a beverage.

Enhanced cleaning and disinfecting of all common areas take place prior to every performance and post-show. Hand sanitizer is also available at the entrance and at the bar.

In addition to these precautions, two HEPA filters have been placed in the lobby and theatre area to increase air quality.

We will also be monitoring the situation and government protocols and will create further restrictions as required.
